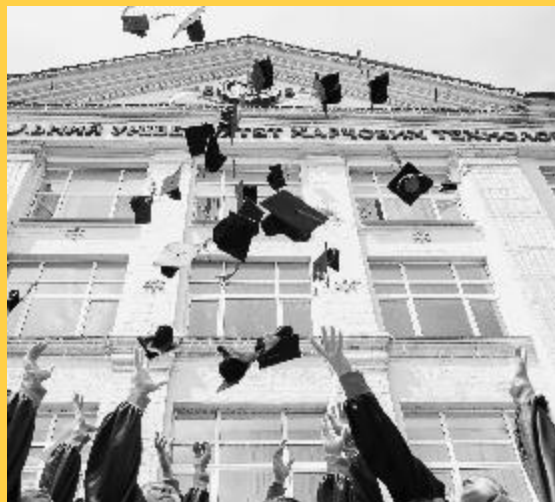

Focus on Career Exploration

The Adult Education Transition Counselors can assist you with focusing on Career Exploration. Amy McLaren or Michelle Colleoc can assist you with taking the all-important next step to start a new career or enroll in a career education or degree program. When we ask the million dollar question, "What do you want to do?", many students answer, "I don't know." This is where the counselors step in to provide a career assessment (Career Cruising). Students will learn what type of learner they are, set short term and long term goals, and will explore their top five career choices utilizing O*Net. If students feel inclined to dual enroll at Barstow Community College while taking Adult Education courses, this option will be discussed one-on-one with the guidance of the transition counselor.
